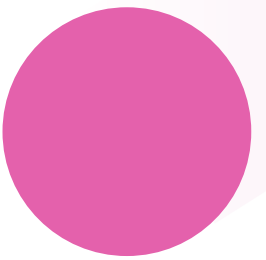
This is a two-part, agile service:
